



VOTER REGISTRATION 2024

CHANGES FOR 2024!

- Photo ID or exception form will be required
- Absentee Ballots will need Photo ID or exception form too!
- People convicted of a felony must have completed ALL probation, supervision or parole and must reregister
- Express Vote devices will be used for marking ballots this year for *Early Voting* only

WHO CAN VOTE?

- U. S. Citizen
- Resident of the county where you are voting
- At your address for the last 30 days prior to the election
- 18 on or before election day (may vote as a 17 year old in the Primary of the Election for which you will be 18)
- * Not currently serving sentence (including any probation, post-release supervision, or parole). *
- Must rescind any previous registration

HOW TO VOTE - Step 1

1. *REGISTER* to vote at least 25 days before Election Day – Oct. 11 for Nov. 2024 Election




2. **PREPARE** to vote by going to the BOE website



HOW TO REGISTER

- Be sure you meet all requirements for voting
- CHECK your registration online
- GET a registration form online or at the BOE
 & mail it in or drop off at the BOE office or
- ONLINE at the DMV website
- RE-REGISTER if your name, address, or party affiliation changes

How about college students??



- May register and vote in the county where they are attending college
- May register or remain registered at the address where they lived previous to moving away for college

They can choose!

What about 17 year-olds??

- If you'll be 18 by the date of the general election, you can register and vote in that election's primary
- 16 year olds can pre-register too!




WHEN TO REGISTER

No later than 25 days before
 the election – Oct. 11 for Nov. 2024

 If you miss the deadline, you can still register during Early Voting – Oct. 17 – Nov 2

16 & 17 year-olds can pre-register anytime

HOW TO REGISTER VOTERS



WHO CAN REGISTER OTHERS?

- ANYONE!
- No special certification required
- You don't have to be eligible to vote to register others

YOUR OBLIGATIONS

- NEVER try to influence political party choice
- You MAY complete the form for someone but they must sign and date it
- You MAY NOT copy or record any personal information from the form
- You MUST turn in completed forms in a timely manner

ABSENTEE BALLOTS 2024

- Any NC Registered Voter
- No reason needed
- Absentee Ballot must be accompanied by a copy of Photo ID or completed exception form

- Step 1 submit Absentee Ballot Request Form via portal or paper
- Step 2 complete Absentee Ballot
 BOE will mail absentee ballot to you with return envelope
 Must be witnessed by 2 people over 18 or 1 notary

ABSENTEE BALLOTS cont.

 Step 3 – place completed ballot in ballot envelope & seal; place Photo ID or exception form in clear plastic sleeve

Voter and either 2 witnesses or 1 Notary must **sign** back of ballot envelope

Place both in return envelope & seal – use 3 first class stamps

 Step 4 - mail Absentee Ballot or drop off at BOE or at any Early Voting site during Early Voting
 If hand-delivered to the Board of Elections office, only the Voter or near relative may deliver and must sign a log
 If dropped of at Early Voting site, it must be delivered to election official at check-in station

READ INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE MARKING YOUR BALLOT

A VOTER MUST INCLUDE A COPY OF AN ACCEPTABLE PHOTO ID OR A PHOTO ID EXCEPTION FORM

If you cannot include a photocopy of an acceptable photo ID you will need to complete the Photo ID Exception Form.

Eligible forms of photo identification include:

Any of the following that is unexpired, or expired for one year or less:

- North Carolina driver's license
- State ID from the NCDMV (also called "non-operator ID")
- Driver's license or non-driver ID from another state, District of Columbia or U.S. territory (only if voter registered in North Carolina within 90 days of the election)
- U.S. Passport book or U.S. Passport card
- North Carolina voter photo ID card issued by a county board of elections
- College/University student IDs and government employee IDs approved by the State Board of Elections

Note: A voter 65 or older may use an expired form of acceptable ID if the ID was unexpired on their 65th birthday.

Any of the following, regardless of whether the ID contains an expiration or issuance date:

- Military or veterans ID card issued by the U.S. government
- Tribal enrollment card issued by a tribe recognized by the State or federal government
- ID card issued by an agency of the U.S. government or the State of North Carolina for a public assistance program

College/University student IDs and government employee IDs approved by the State Board of Elections

Note: A voter 65 or older may use an expired form of acceptable ID if the ID was unexpired on their 65th birthday.

Your ballot container envelope ("ballot envelope") <u>has two sides that require your attention</u>. One side has a place for you to provide a <u>copy</u> of your Photo ID (DO NOT SEND THE ORIGINAL ID) or your Photo ID Exception Form, which you will complete if you are not able to provide a copy of a Photo ID.

The other side has the form printed on the envelope that must be completed by you, your witnesses or notary, and your assistant (if needed).

Remember that your ballot will be placed <u>inside</u> the ballot envelope and sealed. The copy of your photo ID or your completed Photo ID Exception Form will go in the clear sleeve on the <u>outside</u> of the ballot envelope. <u>DO NOT</u> place your photo ID or Photo ID Exception Form inside the sealed envelope with your ballot.

You must complete all required sections on both sides of the ballot envelope in order for your ballot to be accepted.

ABSENTEE BALLOTS cont.

- Absentee Ballots -- whether mailed or handdelivered -- must be received by the Board of elections by 7:30 pm Election Day – Nov. 5, 2024
 - Legislation in 2023 canceled the 3-day grace period for the Board of Elections to receive Absentee Ballots

ABSENTEE BALLOTS cont.

Multiparty Assistance Teams (MAT Teams)

- Allowed to drop off completed Absentee Ballots
- Appointed by county BOE to assist with mail-in voting for voters living in nursing homes & the like
- MAT Teams consist of a minimum of 2 people who have different party affiliations

What about Photo ID??







- Photo ID is now required!
- Voters will be asked to show Photo ID at polling places or complete an exception form
- Absentee ballots must include a photocopy of their Photo ID or a completed exception from

- Acceptable IDs listed on NCSBE website: https://www.ncsbe.gov/voting/voter-id#acceptable
- ✓ NC Driver's license
- ✓ State ID from NCDMV
- ✓ US Passport or Passport Card
- ✓ NC Voter ID issued by County BOE
- ✓ Approved college or university IDs
- ✓ Approved government or charter school IDs
- ✓ Military or vets ID card issued by US Govt.
- ✓ Recognized tribal enrollment card
- ✓ Public assistance program ID card issued by US govt. or state of NC

Photo ID cont.

What if you don't have a Photo ID?

- You can still vote
- You must fill out an ID Exception form and vote a provisional ballot
- OR
- Vote with a *provisional ballot* and bring *Photo ID* to county BOE by the day before county canvass Nov. 24 for the 2024 election



EXPRESS VOTE Machines

- A way to mark your ballot with a touch screen
- Was used in 2023 for all Early Voting
- Election Day voting unchanged
- Already in use in 11 counties in NC
- Still uses a paper ballot that will be marked using Express Vote device then read, as always, by scanning device
